- 1. Welcome and approval of agenda The draft agenda was approved.

- Confirmation/Approval of the last tcon's minutes The draft last tcon's minutes was approved.
- 4. Decree 187, Circular 4 and 23
 - 1) Summary of the view on Decree 187, Circular 4 and 23 Patricia summarized the view as follows.
- We should focus on Decree 187 and Circular 23, and not focus on Circular 23 as it provides information of criteria, documentation, procedure for importing machinery.
 - Hanh will conduct more detailed analysis on Decree 187 and Circular 4.
 - There were no additional information to be shared from the participants.

How we should proceed from now on? in house external office such as low firm?

- Masami proposed contacting MOH officer and simply ask about importing used equipment.

Low firm or internal analysis?

- Mike proposed the analysis by local colleagues in Vietnam should be continued.
- A common approach and the best practice for this topic to be studied by ourselves as a law firms are not always effective. We have to be sensitive what is the most effective.
- 5. Trade agreement aspect (Intelligence about the trade agreement)

EU-Vietnam Free trade agreement

- The information of EU Vietnam Free Trade agreement was shared.
- "Remanufactured medical devices" are treated as an item allowed for the trade.
- Was "Remanufactured medical devices" in the agreement from the beginning or added later? If it was added later, it may helpful for our strategy.

Japan-Vietnam EPA (Economy Partnership Agreement)

- It was agreed in 2008 and consists from General matters and Tariff.
- No specific description of used/refurbished equipment for the trade.
- 6. Exchange on further information on examples for exemptions from other industries Automobile, Machinery were discussed before. Is there anything else?
 - No further information were available from Caterpillar/Heavy duty/Machinery field.
